#### • Grade 7 students:

- o Grade 7 school orientation is on Tuesday 3 September 2024. Students will attend the full day (8:25-3:03).
- o Grade 7 students will attend the full day Wednesday 4 September 2024.

#### • Grade 8 and 9 students:

- No classes/no school for Grade 8 and 9 students on Tuesday 3 September 2024.
   Enjoy your extra day of summer!
- Grade 8 and 9 student orientation and school set-up will be Wednesday 4
   September 2024. Doors open at 8:15 am. We will meet in the school gym to begin.
- $\circ$  Dismissal on full days of school is 3:03 for this school year.

## • Grade 7, 8 and 9 students:

- Students will continue their orientation on Thursday 5 September 2024.
   Dismissal on Thursdays is 11:55 am.
- o All students will follow their class timetable on Friday 6 September 2024.

# • Generations 7, 8 and 9 students:

- Students who are **new to St. Mark** this year are invited to attend on Tuesday 3
   September 2024 for their orientation.
- o All Generations students will attend school on Wednesday 4 September 2024.

We know there are likely many questions from especially our new family members. Further is some information that may help:

#### Bus Passes

- Except for Generations, students requiring transportation use Edmonton Transit Services (ETS).
- ECSD is no longer offering bus passes for hardship cases. If you require financial assistance for your child's bus pass, you are asked to apply to the ETS <u>Ride Transit</u> Program (https://www.edmonton.ca/ets/subsidized-transit).

#### School Fees

- General School Fees and all Recreational Academy Fees will be ready for payment starting 15 September 2024 on <u>PowerSchool</u>.
- o Option fees will be determined and added to your child's PowerSchool account near the end of the first month of options. This will allow us to settle students in the option classes as changes are inevitable in the first few weeks of school.
- General school fees and option fees can be paid in monthly installments. Please contact the office to arrange this.
- Recreation fees are due at their prescribed time as per the contract families signed.
   Missed payments may mean the student is removed from the program until fees are paid.

#### Locks and Lockers

- All students will be provided with a locker <u>and a lock</u> by the school.
- Personal locks will be removed and replaced by a school lock. This is for school security purposes.

# School Supply List

- o Please see our <u>website</u> for a list of supplies for the first day of school. St. Mark does support the reuse of older school supplies that are in good working condition.
- A school agenda is part of the students' fees and will be provided the first day of school.

• Once options have been finalized, students may require additional materials. This will be communicated by the individual teachers later.

## • St. Mark Student Cellphone Policy

- Please see the attached letter from the Minister of Education regarding the use of cellphones in Alberta Schools.
- St. Mark does NOT allow students to use their cell phones at any time during the school day (8:15-3:03). Students have access to a school phone to make calls during the day. Our school policy will be shared with students during orientation and families during our Meet the Teacher Evening.
